How To Enter the 2026 Teen Masters Global Championships

The registration fee is \$425 and includes one SKILL 3.02 bowling ball, at least 18 games of competition, two personalized 2026 Global Championships jerseys, a personalized credential, the official practice session, and free admission to the competition for family and friends.

- Step 1: Go to TeenMastersGlobalChampionships.com.
- Step 2: Click the **Vegas Sign Up** button, then click Sign Up under Log In to create an account.
- Step 3: Complete all details, then click on the **Create Your Account** button at the bottom of the form.
- Step 4: Validate your account by inputting the 6-digit code sent to your email.
- Step 5: Click the **Vegas Sign Up** button again, and use your email and password to Log In.
- Step 6: Click the **2026 Global Championships Registration** and add it to your cart.
- Step 7: If you do not have a **SKILL 3.02** bowling ball, add one to your shopping cart now or later. SKILL balls will be available on-site in Las Vegas.
The SKILL 3.02 is the only ball allowed at the 2026 Global Championships and will continue to be used in 2027 and beyond. You may bring two SKILL 3.02s to Las Vegas, but you must designate one for the competition after the official practice session.
- Step 8: Check Out. *The site accepts credit cards, PayPal, and PayPal Pay Later. PayPal Later allows you to make four interest-free payments. On future visits to the website, click the Teen Masters Member.*

2026 Teen Masters Global Championships Format

Entries will be limited to the first paid 16 males and 16 females from each of four regions:

- Asia-Pacific, Middle East
- Europe, Mediterranean, and Africa
- Latin America, Caribbean
- North America

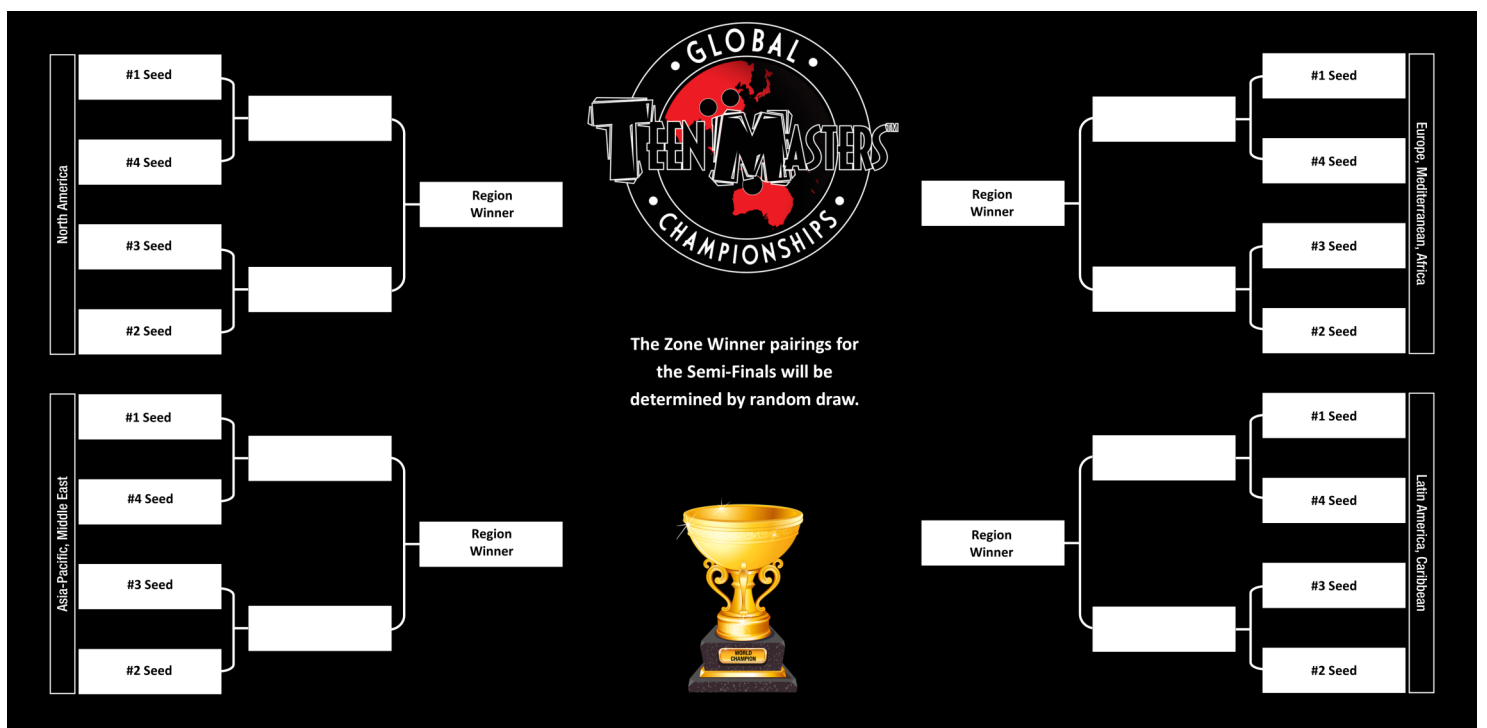
Separate Global Championships will be staged for boys and girls.

Using a single SKILL 3.02 bowling ball, all athletes will bowl a six-game block on the following lane conditions:

- SKILL 46 – a 46' low-volume pattern
- SKILL 35 – a 35' low-volume pattern
- Dual Pairs – SKILL 46' on the even numbered lanes, SKILL 35 on the odd numbered lanes

Participants will receive ranking points based on finish position for each block. For example, 1st will receive one point while 12th will receive 12 points. Based on ranking points for all three blocks, the top four boys and top four girls from each region with the lowest totals will advance to the single-elimination phase of the competition.

Matches will consist of two games. If the same athlete wins both games, the winner advances and the loser is eliminated. A 1-1 tie will be broken by a 9th/10th frame roll-off.



Teen Masters Global Championships Awards



Gold, silver, and bronze medals will be awarded to the overall leaders in the following categories for both boys and girls:

- SKILL 46
- SKILL 35
- Dual Pairs
- All Events (*based on Ranking Points*)

The male and female global champions and runners-up will be presented with **commemorative trophies**.

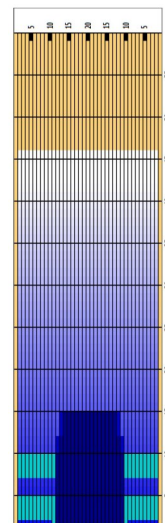
Tournament Patterns

SKILL 46

SKILL 46 is a low-volume SKILL lane conditioner pattern designed to encourage bowlers to play toward the **inside** of the lane.

- Pattern length: 46'
- Volume: 6.5 to 7.5 mL
- Ratio: 3 to 1

The low-volume oil pattern, combined with the SKILL 3.02 bowling ball, creates a stable scoring environment in which “who you follow” doesn’t play a role in your success or failure.

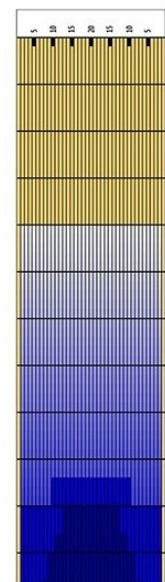


SKILL 35

SKILL 35 is a low-volume SKILL lane conditioner pattern designed to encourage bowlers to play toward the **outside** of the lane.

- Pattern length: 35'
- Volume: 6.5 to 7.5 mL
- Ratio: 3 to 1

The low-volume oil pattern, combined with the SKILL 3.02 bowling ball, creates a stable scoring environment in which “who you follow” doesn’t play a role in your success or failure.



2026 Teen Masters Global Championship Rules

1. **Scratch.** The Teen Masters Global Championships (TMGC) is a scratch competition.
2. **Eligibility.** The 2026 TMGC is open to all amateur athletes who are **19 or younger on 6 February 2026**.
3. **Capacity.** Entries will be limited to the first paid 16 males and 16 females from each of four regions:
 - Asia-Pacific, Middle East
 - Europe, Mediterranean, and Africa
 - Latin America, Caribbean
 - North America
4. **Registration.** The registration fee is \$425 and includes:
 - One SKILL 3.02 bowling ball delivered upon arrival in Las Vegas.*
 - Minimum of 18-games of TMGC competition.
 - Two (2) personalized official TMGC jerseys.
 - Personalized TMGC credential.
 - Official practice session.
4. **Divisions.** Separate divisions for males and females will be contested.
5. **Bowling Ball Policy.** Participants are permitted to use a single (1) SKILL 3.02 bowling ball (13#, 14#, or 15#) for all TMGC competition. The SKILL 3.02 is a pearlized urethane ball specifically designed to reduce flare and oil absorption. While participants may bring two SKILL 3.02 balls to the event, only one can be designated for competition after the Official Practice Session. A second SKILL 3.02 may be introduced *only* if the Tournament Director confirms the original ball is irreparably damaged from regular play.
6. **Static Balance.** Maximum Top/Bottom Weight - 3 oz. Maximum Side/Finger/Thumb Weight - 1 oz. All balls will be checked for compliance.
7. **Holes.** The number of holes or indentations shall not exceed five and shall be limited to one for each finger and one for a thumb hole, all for the same hand. Each hole or indentation must fit the size of the corresponding finger or thumb. *TMGC reserves the right for its representatives to bring a ball into static weight compliance with a small balance hole.*
8. **Release Orientation.** Bowlers must release the ball in the drilled orientation. If a ball does not have a thumb hole, the ball must be scribed or engraved with a "+" near the center of the palm to indicate the grip orientation. When delivering a ball without a thumb hole, the palm must cover the "+." When delivering a ball with a thumb hole, either the thumb must be inserted, fully or partially, into the thumb hole, or the palm must cover the thumb hole.
9. **Wrist Devices.** Because we believe that ball motion variations are the bowler's responsibility, wrist supports containing plastic, metal, or pads are prohibited. Gloves that do not contain rigid metal, plastic, or a pad are allowed. Wrist tape is permitted.
10. **Extreme Lofting.** Out of respect for our host centers and to prevent damage to the lanes, lofting the ball past the arrows is not allowed.
11. **Dress Code.** Each athlete must wear an official 2026 TMGC jersey and black dress slacks for men and skirts, skorts, dress shorts, and dress slacks for women. Skirts, skorts and shorts must be longer than fingertip length when standing with arms down at your sides. No jeans of any color will be allowed at any time. Casual attire, including T-shirts, jeans, shorts, and cargo pants, is acceptable during the Official Practice Session and Blind Draw Team Mixer.
12. **Publicity Release.** By entering the TMGC, the bowler acknowledges Killer 'B' Promotions' (KBP) right to make use of and to permit others to make use of the bowler's name, scores, voice, pictures, photographs, and other likenesses for any purpose in any manner related to the advertising, broadcast, publication, or promotion of the TMGC.
13. **Event Cancellation.** In the event of cancellation caused by circumstances such as an act of God, war, or civil unrest, as solely determined by KBP, all submitted entry fees will be fully reimbursed.
14. **Refunds.** No refunds will be allowed after 1 January 2026.
15. **Ownership & Trademark.** TMGC is owned and operated by Killer 'B' Promotions (KBP). The decisions of KBP are final.
